Central Fladen Grounds Cod Closed Area Process

- 1.UKFMC will monitor any incursions in to the designated closed area and report these to SFSAG (Mike Park and Jennifer Mouat)
- 2. If the vessel is a SWFPA member a request will be sent to the vessel via the SWFPA office requesting that they please cease any activity in the closed area:

- 3. If a further incursion is identified by UKFMC the vessel will receive a warning. On a third incursion the vessel will be removed from the MSC Cod vessel list for a period of one month.
- 4. Any further incursions by said vessel will result in its removal from the MSC Cod vessel list for a period of six months. With any further incursions resulting in a permanent removal from the MSC Cod Vessel List.
- 5. Any removal, temporary or permanent, will be effective from the 1st of the next calendar month with all Sales Agents being informed.
- 6. The vessel may provide a reason for any incursion into the closed area, however, acceptance or otherwise is at the discretion of SFSAG.
- 7. If the vessel is not a SWFPA member the appropriate Producer Organisation will be contacted and will follow the process from point number 2 onwards.
